Students will visit key cities around the United Kingdom on live, interactive, virtual sessions with our local experts, making them familiar with the country and its daily life.

Note: The introductory module detailed in this brochure covers London and Oxford while our advanced modules also include Cardiff, Dublin and Glasgow providing students with a complete orientation of the U.K.

SOFT SKILLS



Effective communication skills through Drama



In this live, classroom-based session by the International Drama academy in the U.K., students will learn effective communication skills using drama, story-telling, voice and breathing techniques.



Intercultural competence, social & emotional skills



A live, virtual, International Student Exchange where learners will collaborate with students in the U.K. and gain social & emotional skills, intercultural competence and problem-solving skills.



Creative skills on a Harry Potter-inspired quest



On this live, interactive, virtual quest students will visit sites in London relevant to the Harry Potter series and use creative skills and teamwork to solve a puzzle.

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WHAT LEARNERS WILL GAIN ON THIS PROGRAM

The understanding of other countries and cultures, as well as soft skills, is vital for youngsters to adapt to an increasingly globalised world. There is an urgent need to complement classroom based education with such knowledge in order for the next generation to be better prepared to navigate a global future. Through our pioneering International Readiness & Soft Skills program which uses live, world travel as a medium, students will gain;

International Orientation

Learners will explore the U.K. on live, interactive sessions, helping them develop international destination awareness and an understanding of the local culture.



Soft Skills training

Soft skills training conducted by International coaches that include effective communication, intercultural competence, creativity, social & emotional skills, problem solving and team work.

Certifications

PROGRAM DETAILS



SESSION 1- VISIT LONDON - DESTINATION & DAILY LIFE AWARENESS

On this live-streamed, interactive session, students will explore London with our local presenter. Attendees will visit some of the most iconic highlights in the city while also gaining knowledge about daily life in the U.K.

As students explore Westminster they will be able to appreciate the seamless juxtaposition between the ancient and modern. They will learn about London's origin story against the backdrop of the Thames, Westminster Abbey, the Big Ben, and Trafalgar Square. They will learn about the city's more recent history against the Houses of Parliament, Churchill's war rooms and Whitehall. On a visit to Buckingham Palace, students will learn about the monarchy and the many cultural traditions that the country celebrates.

This session is designed to make learners closely aware of life in the U.K. Attendees will briefly visit a tube station, venture into a local shop and become familiar with day to day living in the country. The session is highly interactive enabling students to cement their awareness of the U.K.





SESSION 2- VISIT OXFORD UNIVERSITY - DESTINATION & STUDENT LIFE AWARENESS

On this live, interactive, virtual visit to the University of Oxford, students will get a unique opportunity to learn about one of the world's oldest and most renowned educational institutions. The University includes 38 colleges, libraries, and faculty buildings and is famous for the many notable students it has produced through its 800 years of history.

Through this session we hope to inspire youngsters to be audacious thinkers who can envision a global future with limitless possibilities.

The session is led by a student from the University who has gone through the interview process and experienced the traditions, giving attendees the opportunity to gain first hand insights about student life here, and in the U.K. in general.

As we tour the University, students will see landmarks like the University Church of St. Mary, Radcliffe Camera, and Trinity College and also get a sneak peek inside the illustrious Bodleian Library.

Harry Potter fans will be able to see inside the Divinity School—which featured as the infirmary & classroom space in Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry.





SESSION 3- SOFT SKILLS- LEARN EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION THROUGH DRAMA

In this classroom-based, interactive session, voice and drama coaches at the LAMDA accredited International Drama Academy in London will use drama and storytelling to teach effective communication skills. In this session students will;

- Learn the mechanics of voice and the science of speech.
- Use storytelling to learn to bring a range of texts to life using diction, emotion, enthusiasm and character.
- Develop vocal control when speaking for clarity, pace, inflection, pitch and projection.
- Enhance pronunciation by participating in vocal exercises.
- Learn speaking exercises that highlight both nouns and consonants

SESSION 4- INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE

SOFT SKILLS: INTERCULTURAL COMPETENCE, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL SKILLS, TEAM WORK, PROBLEM SOLVING.

One of the primary aims of this program is to provide young learners with intercultural competence, social & emotional skills and collaborative abilities that will help them thrive in an interconnected global society.


In this virtual, International Student Exchange, attendees will collaborate with students in the U.K. on specific tasks relating to global issues like climate change, gender equality and educational inequity.

This session is designed to help students go beyond pre-conceived notions and stereotypes about other cultures and to form bonds beyond borders as they come together to solve problems.

An example of the kind of problems that the group will discuss and solve would be to find solutions for disadvantaged children in Kibera, the largest slum in Africa, whose education has been disrupted because of Covid. Students will jointly arrive at possible ways to solve such problems and work on an action plan and proposal that will be submitted to governments and heads of states.

The group will have the opportunity to continue to stay in touch as they monitor the progress of the solutions they proposed.

SESSION 5- HARRY POTTER INSPIRED QUEST- SOFT SKILLS: CREATIVITY & TEAM WORK

The final session in our introductory program is fittingly entertaining as well as educational, as attendees will go on a live, virtual, quest around locations in London inspired by the Harry Potter series. However, this is not just a session for Harry Potter enthusiasts. This is an experience that requires students to use creative skills and team work to solve a puzzle as they take in the different sights.

For the uninitiated, Harry travels to and through London in all eight films, most of which were filmed here. In this session, our presenters will take students through London, pointing out these locations. Students will be paired into four separate groups and will compete in a tournament to solve a puzzle based on the locations they visit.



Students will explore the real Diagon Alley, see the structures that house the Ministry of Magic, walk through the Underground barriers Harry and Arthur Weasley crossed on their trip to London and stand on the bridge destroyed by Death Eaters. They will also get a chance to see the 'Palace Theatre', now home to the '*The Cursed Child*' play.

Groups will have to piece together clues on the tour to solve the final puzzle. The winning group will receive Harry Potter merchandise from London.

FEE STRUCTURE & DETAILS
