SESSION 1- VISIT LONDON - DESTINATION & DAILY LIFE AWARENESS

On this live-streamed, interactive session, students will explore London with our local presenter. Attendees will visit some of the most iconic highlights in the city while also gaining knowledge about daily life in the U.K.

As students explore Westminster they will be able to appreciate the seamless juxtaposition between the ancient and modern. They will learn about London's origin story against the backdrop of the Thames, Westminster Abbey, the Big Ben, and Trafalgar Square. They will learn about the city's more recent history against the Houses of Parliament, Churchill's war rooms and Whitehall. On a visit to Buckingham Palace, students will learn about the monarchy and the many cultural traditions that the country celebrates.

This session is designed to make learners closely aware of life in the U.K. Attendees will briefly visit a tube station, venture into a local shop and become familiar with day to day living in the country. The session is highly interactive enabling students to cement their awareness of the U.K.





SESSION 2- VISIT OXFORD UNIVERSITY - DESTINATION & STUDENT LIFE AWARENESS

On this live, interactive, virtual visit to the University of Oxford, students will get a unique opportunity to learn about one of the world's oldest and most renowned educational institutions. The University includes 38 colleges, libraries, and faculty buildings and is famous for the many notable students it has produced through its 800 years of history.

Through this session we hope to inspire youngsters to be audacious thinkers who can envision a global future with limitless possibilities.


The session is led by a student from the University who has gone through the interview process and experienced the traditions, giving attendees the opportunity to gain first hand insights about student life here, and in the U.K. in general.

As we tour the University, students will see landmarks like the University Church of St. Mary, Radcliffe Camera, and Trinity College and also get a sneak peek inside the illustrious Bodleian Library.

Harry Potter fans will be able to see inside the Divinity School—which featured as the infirmary & classroom space in Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry.









SESSION 3: COMMUNICATION SKILLS AND CONFIDENCE

In this classroom-based session, communication experts at the International Drama & Speech Academy in the U.K. will use activities and breathing techniques to build confidence and effective communication skills to attendees. The aims of this session are to;

- Develop vocal control in speaking for clarity, pace, inflection, pitch and projection.
- Create an understanding of the mechanics of voice and speech.
- To master specialised speaking exercises that highlight both nouns and consonants.
- Develop confidence and team building skills through games and activities.

SESSION 4: INTERVIEW & PRESENTATION SKILLS

In this classroom based session conducted by an International recruiter, participants will learn how to present themselves confidently in a job interview. Attendees will be able to practise in a mock interview situation and gain the confidence for real world interviews. At the end of this session participants are expected to be able to:

- Know how to best present themselves at interviews
- Gain tips on building a good resume.
- Learn how recruiters assess different people's abilities
- Understand what employers are hoping to find from their applicants during an interview.





WEEK 2- MODULE 2: VIRTUAL WORK EXPERIENCE + SOFT SKILLS TRAINING

In this module, students will gain one week of live, virtual, work experience with a U.K. based organisation. The working hours are usually between 9 am to 3 pm GMT from Mondays to Fridays. A mentor from Globe From Home serves as a liaison between the participants and the organisation on an ongoing basis to monitor progress.

Attendees will be given a real-world assignment under the guidance of a team leader from the company.

Please note that the focus of this module is to help learners gain the confidence to work in an international environment, irrespective of the nature of the business.

As students interact with their peers in the U.K. office, they will learn other soft skills like **time management**, **creative thinking and team work.**



FEE STRUCTURE & DETAILS

All our programs are conducted as small group sessions. The destination orientation sessions accommodate upto 100 students. Soft skills trainings and work experience programs are conducted in batches of 30.

WHAT STUDENTS WILL REQUIRE

Students will need a stable internet connection and a mobile device (ideally a desktop or laptop) to stream the sessions and engage in work experience.

WHAT STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE AT THE END OF THE PROGRAM

- Soft skills training certificate from Centre of International Leadership & Learning, International Speech & Drama Academy, U.K.
- Work experience certificate from the organisation that students will be associated with.
